



FATHER'S DAY KEEPSAKE

What you will need

1. A collection of small pictures of things your Dad liked: cars, sport, food or family
2. Wrapping paper can be a good source of patterns
3. PVA glue and a paint brush
4. A clean ,empty container with a lid, maybe a food or takeaway dish
5. Plain paper and pens or pencils
6. A pair of scissors.

Let's Get Started!



Cut and stick!

1. Cut out your pictures and carefully stick them on the inside of the container with PVA glue using a paintbrush to spread the glue
 - REMEMBER your pictures need to be seen from the outside and the base of the container. They also need to be standing upright!
 - Continue until all the container is covered with pictures, they can be overlapping
2. If any of your pictures are not lying flat, you can smooth them out with your glue and paintbrush

Now to decorate the inside!

1. Once the PVA glue has dried you need to stick more pictures on the inside of your container but this time the pictures need to be facing inside of the container
2. Paint a thin coat of PVA glue over all of these pictures to keep them flat and to give a protective covering to your pictures



Finally, the lid!

1. Draw a line around the lid of your container onto coloured or plain paper
2. Cut out just inside the line you have drawn so that it fits inside the lid
3. Decorate the paper with more pictures or a message such as Things that were special to my Dad or anything else you would like
4. Stick the paper on the inside of the lid so that it can be seen through the lid

Time to dry!

Once you are happy with your pattern and detail leave it all to dry completely and you will always have somewhere to keep special things in that remind you of your Dad.
